



'Blankets of Love' is a wonderful initiative started in Australia in 1992, to offer beautiful small quilts to parents of babies who have died at or around the time of birth, as a lasting memento.

Materials

- Soft or brushed prewashed cotton
- Pastel colours, cream or white
- 2oz wadding can be used but for the very tiny quilts may not be required
- Any patterned fabric should be appropriate to the situation

Sizes

Suggested sizes are:

- Small 9 x 12 inches
- Medium 14 x 20 inches
- Large 18 x 21 inches

Details

Keep embellishments to a minimum and scale down any embroidery and quilting. Less is more and some of the simplest quilts are the most beautiful. Always bear in mind that these will be used to wrap the tiniest babies whose skin is very fragile, so they should be soft and delicate.

While we appreciate every quilt that is made it would be really helpful if you could commit to maintaining a steady supply so that we can ensure we keep up with demand. This can be as few or as many as you can realistically cope with.
