

Simple small blanket

Pattern for knitting a simple 6 inch square

- 1 Cast on 40 stitches using 4mm knitting needles and double knitting wool
 - 2 Knit in garter stitch until the square measures 6 inches
 - 3 An easy way to measure if the square is the right length is to fold the knitting in half diagonally and if all the sides meet, then the square should be the right size
- Knitting needles: 4mm knitting needles equate to size 6 USA and size 8 UK

Crocheted baby blanket

- 3.5mm crochet hook and 4ply baby wool, or 4mm crochet hook and DK wool
- Chain to desired width of blanket (even number+3)
- Foundation row: 1 tr. Into 4th chain from hook *miss 1 ch, 2 tr. Into next ch. Repeat from * to end of row.
- Pattern row: 3 ch , 1tr into centre of first 2tr block. * 2 tr into centre of next 2 tr block. Repeat from * to end of row.
- Repeat pattern row until blanket is the desired length and then fasten off

Small plain blanket

- 1 Cast on 30 stitches using 4mm knitting needles and double knitting wool
- 2 Knit 4 rows
- 3 Next row knit
- 4 Next row K3 purl 24 K3
- 5 Repeat last 2 rows until 30 rows have been worked.
- 6 Knit 4 rows
- 7 Cast Off

Small lace blanket

- 1 Cast on 33 stitches using 4mm knitting needles and double knitting wool
- 2 Row 1 – Knit
- 3 Row 2 – Purl
- 4 Row 3 – (P2 tog)twice Yf K1 3 times YO (p2tog) twice
- 5 Row 4 – Purl
- 6 Repeat these 4 rows another 8 times.
- 7 Cast Off

Wool: For all of these patterns please use only neutral colours no pink or blue and as light a wool as possible (to make them as delicate as we can).
